Introduction	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Europe devastated by World War II</li> <li>2. U.S.S.R. emerged as rival superpower to U.S.</li> </ol>
Eastern Europe	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Dominated by Soviets for 45 years             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Industrial advances balanced by Soviet repression</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
Western Europe	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Followed U.S. with strong economic recovery             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. consumer culture</li> <li>2. female equality</li> <li>3. democracy</li> </ol> </li> </ol>
After World War II: International Setting for the West	<p>Western Europe was caught between WW2, the Cold War, and decolonization</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Widespread unification in European nations for first time</li> <li>2. Parliamentary democracies gained ground</li> <li>3. Rapid economic growth</li> </ol>
Europe and Its Colonies	<p>The French, British and Dutch had found hostility in colonies</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Decolonization had went smoother then before the war due to reduced power in the west.</li> </ol>
The Cold War	<p>Hostilities between the US and U.S.S.R. reached beyond the West.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. NATO             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Formed by Western Europeans and lead by US to counter Russian aggressions in area.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. Russia countered with Warsaw Pact             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Pact divided Germany into US/USSR influenced sections.</li> </ol> </li> <li>3. Conflict arose in Middle East and Asia too.             <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
